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**Up to \$2,500 Reward Offered for Information
Leading to Arrest of Burglary Suspect(s)**

Sierra Madre, CA – March 4, 2014 – The Sierra Madre Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for a pharmacy burglary that occurred at Best Buy Drugs located at 29 N. Baldwin Avenue in Sierra Madre.

The cash reward is donated by RxPATROL[®], a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. Further information is available to authorized personnel at www.RxPATROL.org.

Burglary Details for Public Announcement:

The Sierra Madre Police Department and Crime Stoppers are investigating a pharmacy burglary that occurred at Best Buy Drugs, located at 29 N. Baldwin Avenue in Sierra Madre. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public's assistance by offering a reward of up to \$2,500 for any information that will help solve this crime. The reward is donated by RxPATROL.

- **Date/Time:** Monday, January 6, 2014, approximately 12:50a.m.
- **Location:** Best Buy Drugs, 29 N. Baldwin Avenue, Sierra Madre, CA
- **Description of Events:** The suspect pried open the front double glass door to the pharmacy. While inside, the suspect went directly to the Oxycodone, which was located behind the counter, and took an unknown amount of prescription bottles of Oxycodone from the pharmacy. No other narcotics or items were reported as stolen.
- **Suspect Description:** Suspect is described as a white male. He wore blue jeans and a black long sleeve shirt, black shoes and a dark baseball cap.

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
