

**Up to \$2,500 Reward Offered for Information  
Leading to Arrest of Robbery Suspect**

**Omaha, Nebraska – July 21, 2015** – The Omaha Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect believed to be responsible for two pharmacy robberies that occurred at CVS Pharmacy located at 4840 Dodge Street and 1919 N. 90<sup>th</sup> Street, both in Omaha, Nebraska.

The cash reward is donated by RxPATROL<sup>®</sup>, a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. **Robbery Details for Public Announcement:**

The Omaha Police Department is investigating two pharmacy robberies believed to be committed by the same suspect. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public's assistance by offering a reward of up to \$2,500 for any information that will help solve this crime. **Robbery #1 Details**

- **Date/Time:** Monday, June 8, 2015, approximately 4:26p.m.
- **Location:** CVS Pharmacy, 4840 Dodge Street, Omaha, Nebraska
- **Description of Events:** Officers responded to a robbery that had just occurred. The pharmacist reported that the suspect entered the store, indicated that he was armed and demanded Schedule II narcotics. After receiving the narcotics, the suspect ran from the store.
- **Suspect Description:** White male, age 20 to 30, 5'5", 175 lbs. scruffy beard, black shirt, black gloves and tan cargo shorts.

**Robbery #2 Details**

- **Date/Time:** Sunday, June 14, 2015, approximately 2:47p.m.
- **Location:** CVS Pharmacy, 1919 N 90<sup>th</sup> Street, Omaha, Nebraska
- **Description of Events:** Officers responded to a robbery in progress. The pharmacist reported that the suspect entered the store, indicated that he was armed and demanded Schedule II narcotics. After receiving the narcotics, the suspect ran from the store.
- **Suspect Description:** White male, age 20's, 6', 175 lbs. wearing sunglasses, red and blue baseball cap and a blue sweater.
